Instructions for authors



The Revista Portuguesa de Clínica Geral publishes original research articles in family medicine epidemiology and clinical practice, reviews and educational articles, case reports, letters, and other articles that may contribute to the development of Primary Care.

Rules for submission of manuscripts are published annually and will be sent to authors on request.

We also recommend reading "Normas para apresentação de artigos à Revista Portuguesa de Clínica Geral" published in Rev Port Clin Geral 2007;23:75-82, which includes a helpful check-list to use before submission of manuscripts.

RPCG publishes:

- **Editorials:** at the editor's initiative.
- **Original research:** original research relevant to Family Practice or Primary Care. They must have a maximum of 12,000 words and 10 illustrations and should follow the IMRaD style (introduction, methods, results and discussion) and should have a structured abstract in Portuguese and English, keywords and a structured discussion/conclusion.
- **Brief reports:** must be less than 5,000 words and have a maximum of two illustrations, and can describe original research or case reports
- **Clinical reviews:** 12,000 word articles based on bibliographic reviews or a clinical synthesis that provides a clear, up to date account of the topic aimed at family doctors. A maximum of 12 illustrations per article are permitted.
- **Clinical practice:** includes case reports or other descriptions of practice experiences that may be considered relevant in primary care, with a maximum of 8,000 words and four illustrations.
- **Education and training:** projects or experiences descriptions which may be considered important for medical education or specific training, with a maximum of 6,000 words and six illustrations
- **Case reports:** short case histories that describe patients who presented in primary care. They may contain a maximum of 6,000 words and have 8 illustrations
- **Opinion and comment:** these articles aim to stimulate discussion and debate and can cover any aspects of medicine

and health which are relevant to family doctors. They must have a maximum of 4,000 words.

- **Documents:** clinical guidelines, statements or other documents, Portuguese or international, which may be relevant to Family Practice

- **Letters to the Editor:** comments on previously published articles or brief notes about practice with a maximum of 3,500 words and one illustration

Other sections:

- **Dossier:** a group of articles which aim to bring scientific information on a chosen theme up to date.

- **POEM's:** comments on POEM's (patient oriented evidence that matters) published in other scientific magazines

- **Journal Club:** a description of recommended articles, books, or other scientific publications with no more than 3,000 words

- **Web Health:** information about interesting and relevant web sites with no more than 1,000 words.

Articles submitted for evaluation must not have been published in any other magazine or journal.

Authors are responsible for the opinions expressed on their articles.

Published texts are the property of the RPCG and can not be reproduced, in whole or in part, in other publication without permission from the Editor.

RPCG subscribes to the Vancouver rules. The Portuguese translation can be found in Rev Port Clin Geral 2007;23:75-82.
